Passport Services can help travelers apply for or renew a passport or passport card, and take passport photos.

Passport Services will be open Monday through Friday from 2:00 to 5:00 pm and on Saturday from 9:00 am to 12:00 pm, by appointment. Appointments can be made by calling 812.428.8396. Passport Services have been temporarily moved to the Small Conference Room on the second floor of EVPL Central to allow for social distancing.

Passports and passport cards are <u>REAL ID-compliant</u>. Beginning October 1, 2021, travelers 18 and older flying domestically will need REAL ID-compliant identification.
