



Guide to Academic Searches and General Research Using EVPL Encore Catalog

- I. Access our discovery interface
 - a. From homepage
 - i. Begin at evpl.org and enter search term into main search box.
 - ii. Include t: (t, colon, and one space before term(s))
 - b. Go directly to catalog
 - i. Enter encore.evpl.org and navigate to page
 - ii. Include t: (t, colon, and one space before term(s))
- II. Search for keywords **in titles** and locate information from research databases

Here, look for **Flannery** (as in Flannery O'Connor) in the title of publications.

The search will yield both physical materials in the collection, digital editions in digital collections, and items from research databases like EBSCO.

Note – If you are doing this off-site away from an EVPL location, you will need to sign-in from the “Login” (blue button). You’ll need to enter first and last name, barcode number, and PIN number.
