Black History Month Art Contest RULES

- 1. Any Vanderburgh County student of any grade enrolled in a Vanderburgh County school or homeschool may enter. This includes EVSC, private, and parochial schools.
- 2. Each participant may enter a maximum of three pieces of art, but each piece MUST use a different medium (photography, sculpture, watercolor, collage, etc.). Each art piece must have its own registration form.
- 3. Art must represent an aspect of Black History that means something to the artist. This can be a person, place, event, emotion, etc.
- 4. Art must be original to the student, and any art that was purchased will immediately be disqualified.
- 5. Participants must drop-off their art with an official registration form attached at EVPL East by Friday, February 3 at 6:00pm. EVPL East is located at 840 E. Chandler Ave. Hours for this location:

Monday thru Thursday: 9:00 am - 7:00 pm Friday: 9:00 am - 6:00 pm Saturday: 9:00 am - 5:00 pm

- 6. Art will be on display at EVPL East from Monday, February 6 until February 28, 2023.
- 7. Participants are invited to an art show on Friday, February 17 from 5:00-6:00pm. They will be able to meet with guests and discuss their art. Music and snacks will be provided. A committee will select the top three art pieces and present awards that evening. Winners need not be present to win, but it is highly encouraged.
- 8. Art must be picked up at EVPL East from March 1- March 10. Any art not retrieved will become property of EVPL.
