### **SPEAK 2024 Complete Author Series Announced**

*March 6, 2024* – Four authors, including three bestselling novelists and a physician who focuses on the importance of play, will be part of Evansville Vanderburgh Public Library's SPEAK 2024 series.

As previously announced, SPEAK will begin on March 21 with historical fiction writer Kate Quinn. Three additional authors have been added to the series: Elin Hilderbrand, Dr. Anthony DeBenedet, and Victoria Christopher Murray.

"SPEAK 2024 is about intentional enjoyment, and our featured authors are known for helping readers escape into a great story or teaching about the importance of recreation," said Erika Qualls Barnett, Programming Manager, EVPL. "EVPL's annual reading challenge theme, Read - Discover - Play, reminds us of the pleasures of reading, the joy of discovery, and the value of play. SPEAK 2024 presenters will inspire audiences to embrace enjoyment as an essential part of life."

Quinn is a *New York Times* and *USA Today* bestselling author of historical fiction. Her most recent novels prominently feature the roles of women as spies, pilots, snipers, code breakers, and other key protagonists in acts of resistance and espionage during World Wars I and II. These books, *The Alice Network, The Huntress, The Rose Code,* and *The Diamond Eye,* are all best sellers and have had high circulation among EVPL patrons. Quinn will discuss her research and works on <a href="https://doi.org/10.1001/jhar.2007.00">Thursday, March 21 at 7 p.m.</a> in Old National Events Plaza Ballroom A.

Hilderbrand, known as "The Queen of the Beach Read," will speak on <u>Thursday, May 2 at 7 p.m. in Aiken Theatre</u>. Hilderbrand has written 33 novels, primarily set in the summer season of Nantucket. With more than 20 million books sold, Hilderbrand is regularly at the top of the *New York Times* bestseller list and is among the top five circulating adult authors at EVPL.


Dr. DeBenedet is a practicing physician, writer, and behavioral-science enthusiast, and is an advocate for the importance of play in the lives of both children and adults. His interviews and writings have been featured in multiple media outlets, including the *New York Times, Today* show, *Washington Post*, and *TIME Ideas*. Dr. DeBenedet will share his expertise on Tuesday, September 10 at 7 p.m. at EVPL Central.

The SPEAK series will conclude in October with Victoria Christopher Murray, bestselling novelist and Christian fiction writer. Murray is the co-author of *New York Times* instant bestsellers, *The Personal Librarian* and *The First Ladies*. Murray is also a Christian fiction writer, and five of her *Seven Deadly Sins* novels have become Lifetime movies. Murray will speak on <a href="https://doi.org/10.1001/jhar.2007/">Thursday, October 24 at 7 p.m. at lvy Tech Evansville</a>.

Sponsored by the <u>EVPL Foundation</u>, these four events are free and open to all. Special ticketed receptions are planned for Quinn, Hilderbrand, and Murray, with proceeds benefitting the EVPL Foundation.
