The sale will take place in the Browning Rooms at EVPL Central. Hours of the sale are Saturday, November 9 from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m., and Sunday, November 10 from 1 to 3 p.m.

Thousands of items, including books, movies, and CDs, will be available for purchase, mostly ranging between 50 cents and \$2; some specialty items will be more than \$2. A credit card payment option will be available with a minimum purchase of \$10.
